4. Final Phase competition system

Final Phase Men – Final Four Tournament or Home & Away Matches (if no Final Four Organiser)

If a Final Four tournament is organised, it will follow these principles:

The seeding of the Host Team will depend on their place in the final standing at the end of the League Round. If the Host Team is among the four highest ranked teams, they will be placed according to their place in the League Round final standing. If the Host Team finishes lower than fourth, the Host Team will replace the 4th ranked team.

The starting time of the semi-final matches will be confirmed in coordination with the local organisers and the CEV media agency.

General principles:

Semi-Final 1: 2nd Ranked team – 3rd Ranked team
Semi-Final 2: 1st Ranked team – 4th Ranked team

Final Matches:

3rd place match: Loser Semi-Final 1 – Loser Semi-Final 2
1st place match: Winner Semi-Final 1 – Winner Semi-Final 2

Final Phase Women – Final Four Tournament in CZE (venue TBC)

General principles:

Semi-Final 1: 2nd Ranked team – 3rd Ranked team
Semi-Final 2: 1st Ranked team – 4th Ranked team

The match to be played by the CZE national team (as Host Team) depends on their place in the final standing after the end of the League Round. If CZE will be among the four highest ranked teams, Team CZE will be placed according to their position in the final standing of the League Round. If Team CZE finishes lower than fourth, they will replace the 4th ranked team.

The starting time of the semi-final matches will be confirmed in coordination with the local organisers and the CEV media agency.

3rd place match: Loser Semi-Final 1 – Loser Semi-Final 2
1st place match: Winner Semi-Final 1 – Winner Semi-Final 2

6. Challenge System

In case an organiser will be using the Challenge System for the League Round, they must inform the CEV Office (referee@cev.eu) accordingly, **no later than by Friday, 1st March 2024.**

7. Marketing & Commercial Rights

Marketing and commercial rights were shared through the Official communication n°1.

The use of the LED system boarding is optional for League Round matches, but mandatory for semi-final, final and Final Four matches.

Court layout commercial rights: see the layout and check carefully all court layout conditions:

- Net Advertising: 100 % CEV (net band remains empty)
- Net Post Advertising: 100 % CEV (net post covers remain empty)
- Referee chair advertising: 20 % CEV, 80 % NF or 100% empty (CEV approval required)
- Scorer table: NF
- Player benches advertising (backside): NF
- Floor-stickers: 4 positions for NF. In case only 2 are used, they must be symmetrical (2 positions have been ceded by CEV to NF: F1 and F6)
- Floor stickers F3 and F4 are mandatory and have to always be displayed together (5m x 1m)
- Static advertising around the court: see commercial court layout
- In case of LED System use: visibility split is 20% CEV, 80 % NF
 - ➔ The LED playlist (after the LED system application is approved) has to be downloaded from the CEV Cloud, completed and uploaded into the NF folder for CEV approval, please send an email to marketing@cev.eu to inform us about the upload and to seek approval).

CEV protected product categories:

- Betting & gambling*
- Sports equipment: Volleyballs

*For the avoidance of doubt, although the "Betting & gambling services" sector and/or category is reserved by the CEV, the Organiser may exploit, based on prior agreement of the CEV, the category for the "National lottery", provided that their sports betting operations are in no way presented under the same brand as their National lottery operations. Thus, gambling and betting services are prohibited and the category will not be released by the CEV. The CEV partner is the ultimate betting rights holder on a global basis in relation to the CEV Competitions.

Exception: Participating teams may position one sponsor logo of the "betting & gambling" category on the official player jersey. Approval will be given through the certificate for advertising on uniforms.

Organisers wishing to acquire "betting & gambling" advertising rights shall contact the CEV partner AMI as stipulated in the Official Communication n°1.

Approval procedure for LED system playlist (only after the LED system application is approved):

- List of all sponsors with brand name, product category, website, to be uploaded into the Organiser folder on the CEV Cloud.
- LED playlist duly filled in to be uploaded into the folder as well.
- Email to be sent to marketing@cev.eu to notify CEV of the upload
- The files will be approved on the CEV Cloud directly.
- In case any changes need to be made, organisers will be informed by email.
- NO FILES ARE ACCEPTED BY EMAIL.

8. Branding and Graphics

The CEV Cloud is an optimised file sharing and storage solution.

All Organisers have direct access to all resources via a web service interface. The CEV Cloud supports drag and drop file managing. **No logins or passwords are needed.**

Special links take you directly to the CEV online Competition storage with two main folders:

Download, which contains all necessary files / templates you need to use for production of any possible material related to the competition: <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/natteamsdown>

and

Upload, where all files have to be uploaded, checked and approved by CEV before producing. After uploading any files, the Graphics Department (graphics@cev.eu) has to be notified via a short e-mail. No automatic notification is sent to the CEV Office when files are uploaded. The upload folder is structured by organisers: <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/natteamsupl>

Graphics whose production is mandatory:

- Court banners in case of static court layout
- Backdrop
- Poster (printed or electronic versions)
- Podiums (for Final Four or final away match in case there is no Final Four)

If any additional graphics (social media, web promotions, billboards, etc.) are used, they must also be approved in the same way as described above.

All graphics (Banner, Net, backdrop, poster, etc.) shall be downloaded from the CEV Cloud <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/natteamsdown>

Branding guidelines published on the CEV cloud must be followed by all organisers.

LED system information:

Using of LED system boarding:

- League Phase matches – optional
- Final Four – mandatory
- Semi-Final and Final matches – mandatory

The LED system application form must be downloaded from the download folder in the CEV Cloud <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/ledapplform20>

(We recommend reading all the requirements for the use of the LED system and all the information in the application very carefully).

A fully compiled form must be uploaded to the CEV Cloud into your respective folder <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/natteamsupl> **by 19th April 2024**. When uploaded, please send an email to graphics@cev.eu to inform us and request approval.

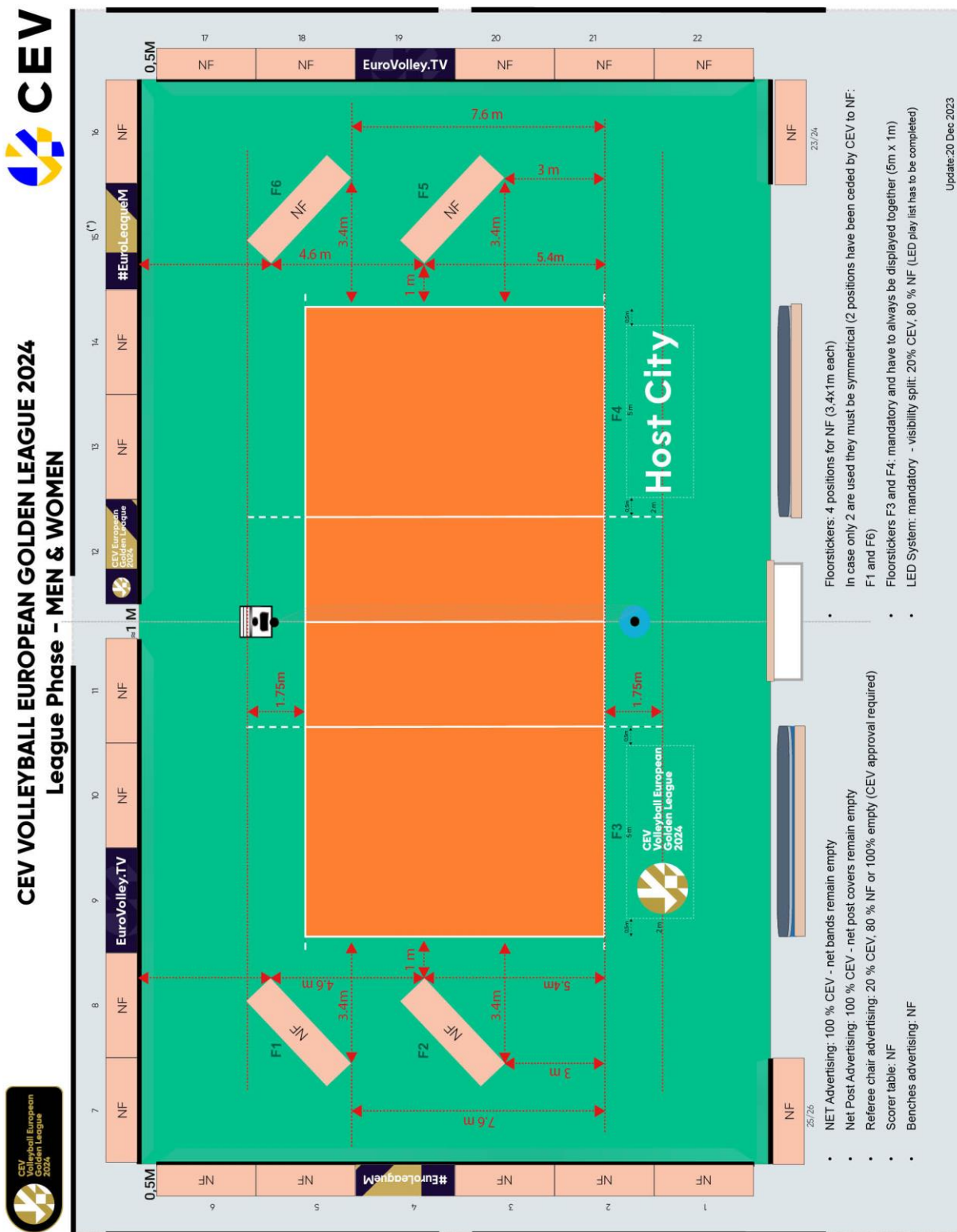
- If not already done so for the LED system, the list of all sponsors with brand name, product category, website, to be uploaded into the Organiser folder on the CEV Cloud.

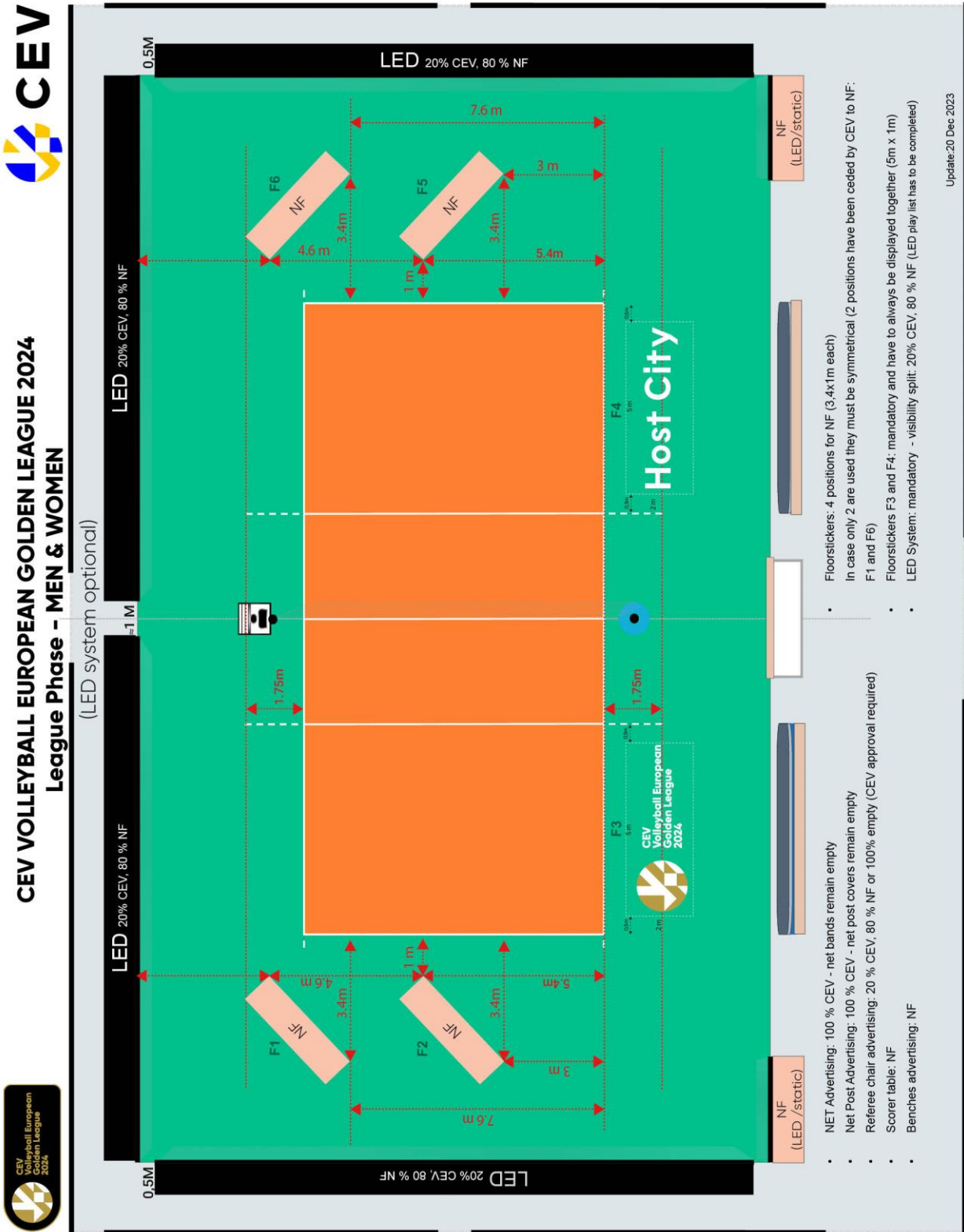
CEV Volleyball European Golden League 2024 – League Phases static panels structure:
